

Ordinance #83

An Ordinance Granting a franchise to Sjoberg's Inc., A Minnesota Corporation, It's successors and assigns, to build, construct, operate and maintain a cable television system in the city of Greenbush and setting forth conditions accompanying the granting of this franchise.

Be it ordained by the people of the City of Greenbush:

There is hereby granted by the City of Greenbush to Sjoberg's, Inc. the right and privilege to construct, erect, operate and maintain in, upon, along, across, above, over or under the alleys, easements, public ways and public places now laid out, or dedicated and all extensions thereof and additions thereto in the City, all pole, wires, cables, underground conduits, manholes and other conductors and fixtures necessary for the maintenance and operation in the City of a cable television system for the transmission of television signals and other signals either separately or upon or in conjunction with any public utility maintaining the same in the city with all necessary and desirable appliances and appurtenances pertaining thereto.

The rights herein granted for the purposes herein set forth shall not be exclusive.

This franchise shall take effect and be in full force from and after acceptance by the city of Greenbush and shall continue in full force and effect for a term of ten (10) years.

Sjoberg's Inc. shall have the option to request renewal of this franchise for an additional period not to exceed ten (10) years.

Sjoberg's Inc. shall provide at least one (1) specially designated VHF access channel available for use by the general public, educational authorities, and local government. Sjoberg's Inc. may also utilize this designated channel when the channel is not in use by the general public, education users, and local government. Sjoberg's Inc. shall establish rules pertaining to the administration of the specially designated access channel which shall be made available upon request.

This ordinance shall become effective upon passage by the City of Greenbush.
