

ORDINANCE NO 56

RELATING TO PEDDLING AND PEDDLERS.

The City Council of the City of Greenbush ordains as follows:

Section 1. No person shall peddle, hawk, sell, expose or offer for sale, any goods, wares or merchandise of any kind, from house to house or on any street, sidewalk, avenue, alley, lane, public grounds, thoroughfare or highway within this village, without having first obtained a license therefore in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 2. The City Clerk shall by and with the consent and approval of the Mayor of the Council, issue a "Peddlers License" of \$15.00 per day to any suitable person, when such person shall have paid to the City Clerk such sum as the Village Council may have determined a fixed fee for such a license, and upon the filing of such receipt with the City Clerk.

Section 3. Any person who violates any provision of Sections one (1) of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than three hundred (\$300.00) and the costs of prosecution, for each and every offense, and in default of the payment of such fine and costs such person may be committed to the County jail for a period not exceeding ninety days.

Section 4. Ordinance No. 10 passed 2-7-1905 is hereby repealed and all ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication. Approved, adopted and passed by the City Council this 17th day of December, 1984.
