

Ordinance No 37

An Ordinance Adopting the Abbreviated Edition of the 1965 Fire Prevention Code as Recommended by the American Insurance Association, and Repealing Certain Ordinances Inconsistent Therewith:

The Village Council of the Village of Greenbush, Roseau County, Minnesota, does ordain as follows:

Section 1: The Fire Prevention Code, 1945 Edition, as recommended by the American Insurance Association governing conditions hazardous to life and property from fire is hereby adopted.

Section 2: Three copies of the above code shall be filed by the Village Clerk in his office for inspection and use of the public, and shall be marked by the clerk with the words, "Village of Greenbush -Official Copy".

Section 3: All ordinance and parts or ordinances inconsistent with the provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4: It shall be the duty of the Village Fire Warden to enforce the provisions of this ordinance. All conditions which to an unreasonable degree endanger life and property from the hazards of fire and explosion arising from the storage, handling and use of hazardous substances, materials and devices, and from conditions hazardous to life and property in the use and occupancy of buildings or premises, shall be inspected, and if found not to be in accordance with the said code, shall be corrected. If after written notice to the person installing work requiring correction thereof, such person neglects or refuses to conform to such order, the Village or any duly appointed inspector may remove such work and charge the cost thereof to the person installing the same. Any new construction shall conform to the provisions of this ordinance, and any person who refuses to correct work when so ordered by the Village Fire Warden, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed \$300.00 or by imprisonment for not to exceed ninety days or both.
