

Ordinance No 30

An ordinance prohibiting the parking and speed of vehicles on certain streets within the Corporate limits of the village of Greenbush and providing a punishment thereafter:

The Village Council of the Village of Greenbush, Roseau County, Minnesota does ordain:

Section 1. (a) No tractors, threshing machines, trucks other than a three quarter ton (or lighter) pickup truck, trailer or automobile to which a trailer is attached shall be allowed to remain parked, or stopped for unloading at any one place of the following described street:

On Third Street (commonly called Main Street) between Highway Number 11 on the South and Minnesota Avenue on the North.

(b) No automobile, truck, thresher, trailer, tractor, or motor vehicle of any kind shall be double parked at one place on the street heretofore mentioned in Section 1-a, for more than three minutes.

(c) The maximum speed limit on the street heretofore mentioned in Section 1-(a) shall be 20 miles per hour

(d) No automobile, truck, thresher, trailer, tractor or motor vehicle of any kind shall be parked at any time in the alleys in the Commercial District of the Village of Greenbush, except for loading or unloading purposes.

Section 2. Any person violating any provisions of this ordinance shall be, guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not less than one dollar nor more than \$50.00, or by imprisonment for not less than one day nor more than 30 days. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

Section 3. Ordinance No 25 dated December 2nd, 1947, is hereby repealed and superseded by the above ordinance.

The foregoing ordinance was duly passed and adopted by the Village Council of the Village of Greenbush on the 2nd day of February, 1965.
