

## Ordinance No 40

### An Ordinance Renaming the Streets and Avenues within the City of Greenbush, MN.

The City Council of the City of Greenbush, Roseau County, Minnesota ordains as follows:

**Section 1:** The Street now known as Third Street shall hereafter be known as Main Street.

**Section 2:** The Street now known as Main Street shall hereafter be known as Sixth Street West.

**Section 3:** The Street now known as Sixth Street, south of McKenzie Avenue will hereafter be known as Sixth Street East.

**Section 4:** The Street now known as Sixth Street, located west of the former Main Street in Klefstad's Third addition, shall hereafter be known as Seventh Street.

**Section 5:** The Street now known as Sixth Street, located west of the former Main Street in Klefstad's Second Addition, shall hereafter be known as Eighth Street.

**Section 6:** The Avenue running east and west in front of the school known as Park Avenue shall hereafter be known as Park Avenue West.

**Section 7:** The Avenue known as Park Avenue between Sixth Street West and Eighth Street shall hereafter be known as Park Avenue West.

**Section 8:** All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this are hereby repealed.

**Section 9:** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force on and after its passage and publication.
