

Ordinance No 57

An Ordinance Adopting the Minnesota State Plumbers Code

The City of Greenbush does ordain:

Section 1. State Plumbing Code Adopted. The Minnesota Plumbing Code of Minimum Standards and Requirements as adopted by the Minnesota Department of Health Chapter 4715, is hereby adopted and shall be in full force and effect in this city insofar as applicable to plumbing and building construction therein. All work done hereafter in this city shall be done in accordance with the provisions thereof.

Section 2. Copies of Code to be Filed. Three copies of the above code as aforesaid shall be filed by the city clerk in his office for inspection and use of the public, and shall be marked by the clerk with the words "City of Greenbush State Plumbing Code - Official Copy." This ordinance shall become effective upon such filing and upon the publication hereof as required by law.

Section 3. Enforcement - Penalty. It shall be the duty of the city engineer (or the building or plumbing inspectors designated by the council) to enforce the provisions of this ordinance. All plumbing work hereafter constructed shall be inspected, and if found not to be in accordance with the said code shall be corrected. If after written notice to the person installing work requiring correction thereof such person neglects or refuses to conform to such order, the city or any duly appointed inspector may remove such work and charge the cost thereof to the person installing the same. Any person covering work without its being duly inspected or refusing to correct work when so ordered by the city engineer shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed \$700.00 or by imprisonment for not to exceed ninety days.
