WHEREAS, the city has been provided a map of the extended liquor serving area, which is attached to this resolution as Exhibit A.

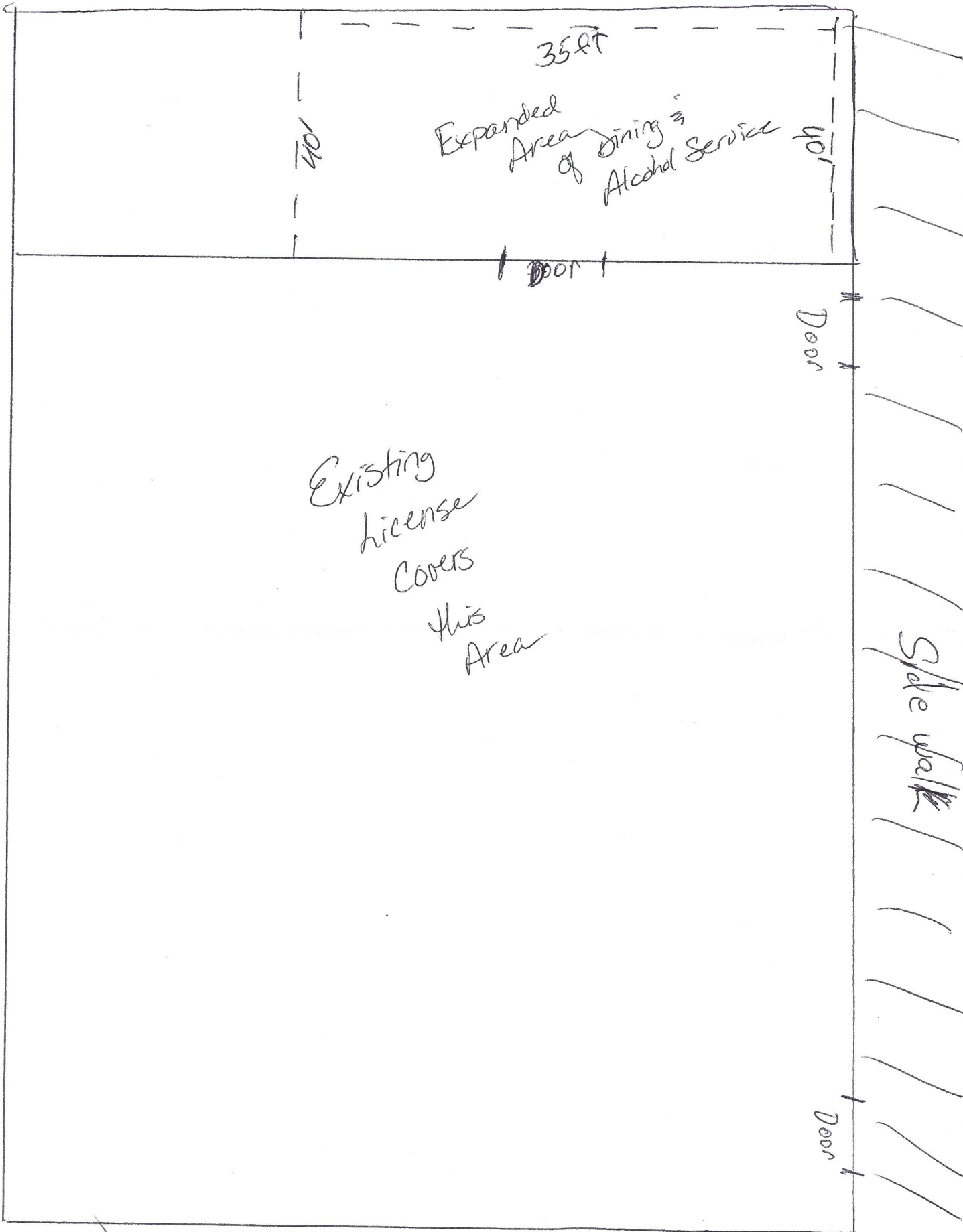
