Public Works Supervisor Shaun Jevne received the MPCA Permit Compliance summary. Jevne shared that everything was reported on time with no errors for the report period of October 1st, 2021- September 30th, 2022. Public works has been working on lift station #1, the meter has been reading high and will need to be replaced. The water treatment plant switched from chlorine gas to liquid. Hawkins will be picking up the old chlorine cylinders later this week from the treatment plant. 40 new water meters have finally arrived, and public works have been busy installing in residential homes and commercial buildings.
