Purpose

The purpose of this meeting is to consider, and possibly adopt, the proposed assessment for 2019 Assessment Job No 1- Watermain Replacement.

The area proposed to be assessed for such improvements is as follows:

Pederson's 1st Addition:
Block 1, Lots 9-10

West Greenbush Addition:
Block 1, Lots 1-11

Auditors Plat of Outlots:
Section 10 T160N R43W

Unplatted Properties:
Section 10 T160N R43W

The council proposes to proceed under the authority granted by Chapter 429 M.S.A.

City engineer Dustin Fanfulik recapped the project. Total cost was \$661,586.84. The city received a grant of \$524,573.00. That leaves a total of \$137,013.84 to be assessed. The cost per foot on these assessments will be \$32.57 per front foot. The proposed assessment was \$55.00 per front foot. No residents came to the meeting and no public comments were made on the assessments.
