

**ORDINANCE NO. 93**  
**CITY OF GREENBUSH**  
**AN ORDINANCE OPTING-OUT OF**  
**THE REQUIREMENTS OF**  
**MINNESOTA STATUTES, SECTION 462.3593**

**WHEREAS**, on May 12, 2016, Governor Dayton signed into law the creation and regulation of temporary family health care dwellings, codified at Minn. Stat. § 462.3593, which permit and regulate temporary family health care dwellings;

**WHEREAS**, subdivision 9 of Minn. Stat. §462.3593 allows cities to “opt out” of those regulations;

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENBUSH ORDAINS as follows:**

**SECTION 1.** Pursuant to authority granted by Minnesota Statutes, Section 462.3593, subdivision 9, the City of Greenbush opts-out of the requirements of Minn. Stat. §462.3593, which defines and regulates Temporary Family Health Care Dwellings.

**SECTION 2 .** This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and publication.
